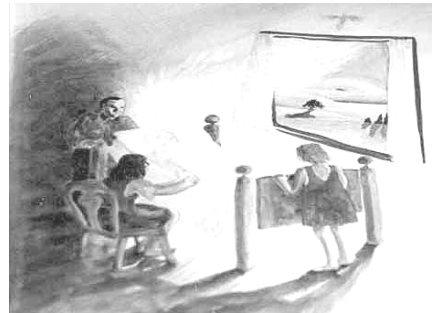

Live actors, puppets, masks and music are used to show the children using play as a means to growth and understanding as they face the miracles and mysteries of this challenging but natural part of life.



Max & Nellie's Journey with Grief prompts discussions between children and adults concerning death, dying and loss. The video is 25-minutes in length and comes complete with a supplemental study guide and activity booklet.
