The Box uses live theatre as a vehicle by which audiences can learn useful tools in identifying and responding to bullying situations. In an interactive style, *The Box* employs improvisation, comedy, magic, and live statuary to excite students while providing practical skills for coping with difficult situations. Through direct audience input, *The Box* explores the idea that not everyone has to be the same to be accepted.

2. The fee for one performance is \$700 ½ of which will be provided with financial assistance from the WV Department of Culture and History
3. Prior to the performance, each school receives a packet with educational resources, activity guides and projects that will prepare students for the show.
4. The only paperwork involved is signing the Old Brick's Letter of Agreement, and completing a post -show brief evaluation.
